COURSE DESCRIPTION

SAT College Prep Mathematics is nine weeks of a semester course to assist students in increasing their SAT Mathematics scores. They will work on verbal the other nine weeks. This will include reviews in number operations, algebra and functions, geometry and measurement, and data analysis, statistics, and probability.

Four SAT Math tests will be taken in this course, a pre-test, progress test, and end of course test, along with a student-edge on-line test.
